General

SPROUT-GARD II is a tree growth regulator product designed to inhibit sprouting of new growth from the pruning of deciduous trees in and around power lines and other vegetation management situations. One application will retard sprouting of new growth for many hardwood species (see list below), and aid in the suberization of the wound to increase the time interval between pruning cycles. Correct tree pruning and trimming practices should always be followed for optimum results.

Treatment

SPROUT-GARD II is a ready-to-use formula that is applied directly to the fresh cuts on the tree at the time of prunning. Remove cap and attach SPROUT-GARD II directly to sprayer, 's system. Apply as a coarse spray (spray to wet, covering entire cut). Spray SPROUT-GARD II on the new cuts on the sides of pruned trees that face the power line. SPROUT-GARD II may be applied any time of the year that pruning operations are done. Do not use more than 4.5 gallons (1.5 lbs. a.i.) of product per acre.* As a general guide this would be r.o., 'more than 72 trees per 8/10 running mile, using no more than 8 oz. of product per treated 'tree.

*In New York State do not apply more than 1.5 gallons (.5 lb. a.i.) per acre per year.

Used as directed SPROUT-GARD II is effective in inhibiting the regrowth of pruned branches of the follow tree species:

Quaking Aspen (Populus tremuloides) Bigtooth Aspen (Populus grandidentata) White Ash (Fraxinus americana) Green Ash (Fraxinus pennsylvanica) Black Ash (Fraxinus nigra) Eastern Cottonwood (Populus deltoides) American Basswood (Tilia americana) Paper Birch* (Betula papyrifera) Black Cherry (Paunus serotina) Black locust (Robinia pseudoacacia) Black walnut* (Juglans nigra) Boxelder (Acer negundo) Sugar Maple* (Acer saccharum) Red Maple* (Acer rubrum) Silver Maple (Acer saccharinum) American Elm (Ulmus americana) Chinese Elm (Ulmus parvifolia) White Oak (Quercus alba) Bur Oak (Quercus macrocarpa) Northern Red Oak (Quercus rubra) American Sycamore (Platanus occidentalis) Tree-of-Heaven (Ailanthus altissima)

*Do not apply to trees that will be used in any manner for food or feed.
