HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

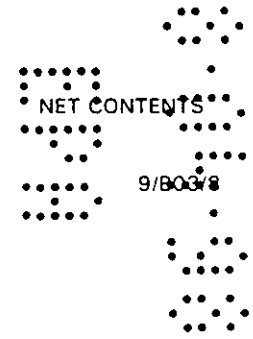

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Atrazine can travel (seep or leach) through soil and can enter groundwater which may be used as drinking water. Atrazine has been found in groundwater. Users are advised not to apply Atrazine to sand and loamy sand soils where the water table (groundwater) is close to the surface and where the soil is very permeable i.e., well drained. Your local agricultural agencies can provide further information on the type of soil in your area and the location of groundwater. This pesticide is toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Runoff and drift from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read the following carefully before application. Use this product only for recommended purposes and at recommended dosage.

For use on St. Augustine and Centipede lawns. Do not use on Bluegrass, Fescue, Bent, Bahia, Rye, Bermuda or Dichondra lawns.

Post emergent broadleaf control of such weeds as: Chickweed, Creeping Charlie, Dandelion, Evening Primrose, Florida Betony, Florida Pusley, Lippia, Oxalis, Pigweed, Pennywort, Plantain, Rabbit Tobacco and Toadflex.

Preemergent control of: Crabgrass, Paspalums, Sedge and Spotted Spurge.

WHEN TO APPLY

For broadleaf post-emergence control apply anytime the weeds are present and actively growing. (Spring application is recommended for best control.) For preemergence control apply before the Crabgrass, Paspalums, Sedge and Spotted Spurge germinate. The precise time of application for a specific area will vary. Consult state agricultural experiment station weed specialist or local turf authorities for any additional information regarding specific weed germination dates in your area.

HOW TO APPLY

This product may be applied with either a drop type or broadcast type spreader.

Apply 4.5 to 6.0 pounds of Magic Carpet Fertilizer with Atrazine 0.92% uniformly over 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn area (equivalent to 1.5 to 2.0 pounds Atrazine per acre.) Watering of treated area immediately after application is recommended to wash pellets off the grass blades.

Chemigation: Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

*IMPORTANT: These settings are only approximate. Age, condition of spreader, and operator speed can cause wide variation. Be sure to calibrate your spreader with each application.

USE PRECAUTIONS

Avoid application under the drip line of trees, shrubs and ornamentals to prevent injury to plants. This product should not be applied to newly seeded Centipede until the new grass has been mowed at least once. Delay spring planting one month and seeding 6 months after application.

Brush off walks and painted surfaces following application to avoid discoloration.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
