



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: Do not take internally. May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash after handling. Wash hands, arms, and face with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Flush contaminated eyes with plenty of water and get prompt medical attention. Do not breathe vapors and spray mist. Avoid spraying food crops. Keep away from food, feedstuffs, and domestic water supplies. Keep container closed. Keep children and pet off treated areas until spray has dried.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. Chlorpyrifos and dichlorvos are organophosphate insecticides. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Keep out of any body of water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Use only as specified on this label.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not use this product through any type of irrigation system.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.
IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Call a physician and get medical attention immediately.
IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention immediately.
IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL (Cont.)

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: (Metal) Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities. (Plastic) Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or incineration, or if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.

PESTS OF LAWNS, AND OTHER ORNAMENTAL & RECREATIONAL TURF AREAS FOR THE CONTROL OF CHINCH BUGS, AND SOD WEBWORMS(LAWN MOTHS) ON "DIFFICULT TO WET" TURFGRASSES.

Apply D + 2 INSECTICIDE uniformly over the turf with water according to the directions given in the following table, and apply as a coarse, low pressure spray using suitable application equipment. For best results, the lawn should be moist at time of treatment and care should be taken to obtain complete and uniform coverage of pest infested areas. Spray when pests first appear, or repeat when needed.

NOTE: Mosquitoes, coming to rest on areas treated for control of Turf insects will be killed for varying periods of time after treatment, depending on exposure of treated areas to weathering conditions.
