Petroleum distillate may present aspiration hazard. Do not induce vomiting unless no other treatment is available and then preferably under medical supervision. If it is necessary to induce vomiting give victim 1 or 2 glasses

3. Please note that a Registration Standard for products containing diazinon was issued in December 1988 and amended on August 24, 1989. give "Pinpoint Control" of insects where they hide, live & breed. **DO NOT USE AS
A SURFACE SPRAY.** Do not use in or on electrical equipment or outlets due to the
possibility of shock hazard.

HOW TO APPLY

No. 1. Add the liquid product directly to the sprayer; No. 2. Treat the area by
spraying into cracks, crevices, holes and other small openings where insects hide
or have been seen.....to give "Pinpoint Insect Control".

WHEN TO USE

Treat infested areas any time insects have become a nuisance and repeat in 10 to
14 days, then monthly as needed in warm climates. In addition to rapid contact kill,
this insecticide stays on treated surfaces and kills insects for up to two weeks after
the spray deposit has dried.

For serious insect infestations release a 1 second "spray blast" for each crack &
crevice "spot". If possible, separate the injection spots about 12 inches apart. For
light infestations or for preventive and maintenance insect control programs space
