1. Make the following listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

a. Delete the claim "Safe for Computer". You must submit documentation on how this product is safe to use on computers. You must also submit the product chemistry study "Dielectric Breakdown" in support of this claim.

b. Delete the words "Harmful (Corrosive) If swallowed" from the front panel.

c. Change "Directions" to "Directions For Use".

d. Include the following misuse statement to fall directly below the heading "Directions For Use".

"It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling".

e. Include the precautionary statement to read:

Precautionary Statments
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
Warning. Causes skin and eyes irritation.
Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing.
In case of contact, flush with plenty of
water. Harmful If Swallowed. Avoid contact
with food.

Statement of Practical Treatment
If swallowed, promptly give milk and induce
vomiting. Followed with more milk. Call
phisician immediately.

f. It is preferrable that the ingredient Section be placed on the front panel of your label.

2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
