Eliminate or prevent mold, fungus or drain pan overflow by the build up of bacterial slime, rust, scale, sludge, air borne dust, dirt and other solids on drain pan water outlets. When used according to directions, Actabs will inhibit the growth of the following organisms: *Thermactinomyces vulgaris*, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Bacillus circulans*, *Bacillus licheniformis*, *Trichoderma reesei* and *Aerobacter aerogenes*.

DIRECTIONS: Remove inner pouch from this bag. Place one pouch as low down on the face of the evaporator coil and as far from the drain line as possible. The tablets should be facing you and the fabric surface should be touching the fins or spines. Secure the pouch in position by pushing the flexible hangers between the fins or spines and looping them over the tubing which supports them. In extremely dirty units it would be helpful to clean the unit before placing the pouch. Use one pouch for each 2 square feet of drain pan area.
