To change the current Primary Brand Name Odorid® (EPA Reg# 9804-3) to become an Alternative Brand Name "Odorid", while the current Alternative Brand Name (ABN): "EnviroCON®" to become the Primary Brand Name of this product (EPA Reg# 9804-3).



<u>Triple rinse as follows</u>: Empty the remaining contents into applications equipment or a mix tank and drain for ten seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container 1/4 fuger seconds

with water and recap. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable Container.

Tip the container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution for 30 seconds. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this process two more times.
