

Dear Mr. Fuller:

The enclosed EPA Form 8570-1 is submitted to correct an error on the subject product label. The change to the label is as follows:

Under the DIRECTIONS FOR USE, the current accepted label reads as, "For <u>residential</u> control of odors associated with bacteria, mold, mildew......"

The label has been corrected to read as, "For <u>residual</u> control of odors associated with bacteria, mold, mildew......"

The only label change by this notification is the correction of the word "residential" to "residual."

Prior to the product Master Label accepted on May 29, 2003, the label correctly stated "residual." Subsequently, on all Master Labels from May 29, 2003 onward, the word "residual" was changed to "residential." The reason for the change is not certain at this time. We speculate that the inadvertent change was the result of a transcription error when the label was reformatted into new document processing software or operating system. The words are similar enough that the transcription error was not identified in proofreading.

A copy of the corrected master label with the change highlighted in yellow is attached. The highlighted change is shown on page 2.

Stand container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this process two more times.
