DIRECTIONS

Apply spray to the animal from a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered including the legs and under the body. As you spray, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate into the fur. Make sure spray wets ticks. Spray on the basis of a 20 - 30 second application to a 25 pound animal. Repeat treatments, if necessary; should not be more often than once weekly. Do not spray into eyes, face or scrotum. Do not overspray. Do not use on animal's under 6 week's of age.
