

## FOR INDOOR OR OUTDOOR USE

This product will kill mosquitoes, flies and many other small flying insects when used in Electric Foggers and Flectric Sprayers which are so constructed they will produce a heavy smokelike log. Small particles of insecticide produced by fogging remain suspended in the air longer than particles produced by a standard hand sprayer. The fogging method is effective as an aid in the control of small flying insects outdoors, and is an effective control for certain insects in kennels and barns.

For outdoor use do not attempt to fog when a heavy breeze is blowing as the fog will be carried away before it has an opportunity to be effective against mosquitoes. The ideal time for fogging is around dusk when the wind usually dies down and the temperature at ground level is somewhat lower than that of the air a few feet off the ground. Under such conditions the fog in the treated area will linger for a longer period of time.

The lasting effects of the fog depends on weather conditions and if a wet or dry fog is produced. Wet fog contains larger particles of insecticide that have not been completely vaporized. Wet fog has a more lasting effect than dry fog, however; heavier residue is left by the wet fog which may be harmful to flowers, plants and other vegetation; therefore, dry fog is desirable.

It is not advisable or necessary to hold electric fogger close to any plants or animals to obtain satisfactory results. This special formula may also be used in hand sprayers for insect control.

This ready to use product has a knock-down as well as killing and repeling action. For indoor use; close all the doors and windows in area and allow fog to saturate air for 10 minutes; before ventilating. DO NOT breathe fumes or fog. Do not allow animals to remain in sealed area during fogging. Begin fogging at far end of room and work towards an exit. Do not smoke during fogging operation or permit any electrical motors to be in operation; to minimize fire hazard.

Food and water as well as dishes are to be removed during fogging. Fresh bedding should be placed in animals quarters following treatment. FOR DOGS: Spray lightly where flies congregate; repeating once every 3rd day or as needed to repel flies.

FOR CATS: Use with extreme caution. Spray lightly where flies congregate; repeating once every 3rd day or as needed to repel flies.

In applying fog or spray directly on to an animal; do not permit spray or fog to enter eyes or contact genitals. Apply in short bursts against the coat.


FOR HORSES: Prevents worrying most horses when lightly sprayed on them to repel biting flies. One to two ounces for adults and slightly less for toals.
