DIRECTIONS: Remove protective cap. Holding container upright and away from you, tilt sprayhead until tip engages rim of valve mounting cap. Valve will remain in open position for total release of contents. Place in upright position in an elevated location (if possible) such as on stand or table. Place newspaper under can to protect surface immediately around area of release.

Release the contents of this can for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space. Use additional units for remote areas or where flow of fog is not assured. Close doors and windows and turn off fans and air conditioners. Remove pets and cover or remove fishbowl. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation. Open cabinets and doors to expose spaces to be treated. Extinguish all flames except pilot lights, and release can at least 6 feet away from pilot lights. For best results, leave treated space undisturbed for two hours or more.

CAUTION: Do not remain in treated areas. After treatment, open doors and windows and allow to ventilate for 30 minutes.

WARNING: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide spray mixture or residue is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to the label instructions contact your State Pesticide Environment Control Agency or Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Replace cap and discard containers in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
