Submission dated March 27, 1991

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

As new labels are prepared, make the following label revisions, referring to section 156.10 of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations for further label format clarification:

1. Remove the "petroleum distillate" declaration as an active ingredient and add the percentage to the total for the "Inert ingredients".
2. The STORAGE & DISPOSAL subsection should be written as follows, as noted in PR notices 83-3 and 84-1:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat and open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate container.

3. Reinstate the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS section which includes that statement "HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS", and the subsections CAUTION and PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS.

4. Under the heading DIRECTIONS FOR USE, the following statement must appear: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
5. Reinstate the STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT section.

DRIONE DUST INSECTICIDE SPRAY

DIRECTIONS: Shake well before using. Remove cap, aim valve from about 12 inches from area to be sprayed, and depress button. Avoid heavy deposits on finished surfaces.

ANTS, COCKROACHES and SILVERFISH apply a continuous visible film of Drione underneath and behind stoves, sinks and refrigerators. To control **FLEAS** in animal quarters treat surfaces, particularly bedding, cracks, crevices. Treat ant trails and areas where they enter. A deposit of Drione, if undisturbed, will continue to kill cockroaches for a period of several weeks through desiccant action. Repeat application when effectiveness diminishes.

BED BUGS take bed apart and treat cracks, joints and interior of framework. Mattress should be treated, especially tufts, folds and edges.

CAUTION: Avoid inhalation of spray mist. Avoid eye & skin contact. **FLAMMABLE:** Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS - Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared, or served.

FOOD AREAS - APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY - Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation also would be considered a food area). Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using injection tube in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where roaches, ants and silverfish hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS, OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.

SERVING AREAS - Facilities where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboards, under elements of construction into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed).

STORAGE & DISPOSAL
Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or residue is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. Replace cap and discard containers in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
