SHAKE BEFORE USE. Point valve away from face and press button. Hold can at least 3 feet from surfaces which may stain and 18 inches from plants. OK

FOR CONTROL OF PESTS AROUND THE HOME

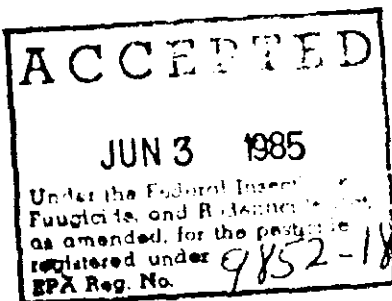
FLYING INSECTS (House Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Moths) Direct spray at insects using short bursts (1 to 2 seconds) or treat unoccupied areas as follows: Close doors and windows. With a sweeping motion direct spray upward to all parts of the room (8 to 10 seconds per 1000 cubic feet). Keep room closed for 15 minutes and ventilate before reoccupying. Do not remain in treated areas.

CRAWLING PESTS (Ants, Boxelder Bugs, Crickets, Earwigs and Sowbugs) - Spray into cracks or woodwork, walls, floors and other hiding and breeding places. Direct spray to contact pests when possible. Spray ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames.

WASPS, HORNETS, BEES and YELLOW JACKETS - Direct spray at these insects using short bursts. Spray thoroughly into nests, hiding and breeding places when insects have settled at night.

To kill LICE and LOUSE EGGS - Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Depress valve and spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Spray each square foot for three seconds. Spray only those garments and parts of bedding including mattresses, and furniture that cannot be either laundered or dry cleaned. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use. Not for Use On Humans.

FLEAS and TICKS (adults and larvae) - Spray sleeping quarters, bedding, floor and floor covering where pets are kept. Repeat as necessary. Use only a recommended pet spray on pets.

PEDBUGS - Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and frames. Repeat treatment as necessary.

OUTDOORS - Camping, fishing, hunting. Spray outer clothing and surroundings. Repels Biting Flies, Black Flies, Mosquitoes, Midges, Gnats - If sprayed every hour or so will aid in keeping surroundings free from mosquitoes. If in rare cases skin irritation results, avoid continued contact.

FOR CONTROL OF PESTS ON ORNAMENTAL PLANTS

For control of aphids, two-spotted spider mites and adult white flies on ornamental house and greenhouse plants (African violet, aralia, Christmas cherry, chrysanthemum, cineraria, dieffenbachia, fuchsia, gloxinia, ivy, lantana, Neanthe bella palm, petunia, rose and snapdragon and on outdoor plants azalea, chrysanthemum, euonymus, ivy, marigold, petunia, rose, snapdragon and zinnia). Spray plants with a slow sweeping motion so that mist drifts into plants. Direct spray so that upper and lower leaf surfaces are contacted. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage. Repeat as necessary. When using outdoors spray when air is still.

For control of these pests as well as tent caterpillars, canker worms and garden webworm on ornamental crabapple, cherries and plum trees, spray as above. Do not spray bearing fruit trees.

DISPOSAL

Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Avoid breathing of vapor or skin contact. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact, flush with water. Do not smoke while spraying. Do not use on or around animals. Cover or remove fish bowls for one hour.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before reuse. When using this product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS
