DIRECTIONS:

Shake before use. Point valve away from face and press button. Hold can at least 3 feet from surfaces which may stain and 18 inches from plants

FOR CONTROL OF PESTS AROUND THE HOME

FLYING INSECTS (Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Moths) - Direct spray at insects using short bursts (1 to 2 seconds) or treat unoccupied areas as follows: Close doors and windows. With sweeping motion direct spray upward to all parts of the room (8 to 10 seconds per 1000 cubic feet). Keep room closed for 15 minutes and ventilate before occupying. Do not remain in treated areas.

CRAWLING PEST (Ants, Boxelder Bugs, Crickets, Earwigs and Sowbugs) - Spray into cracks or woodwork, walls, floors and other hiding and breeding places. Direct spray at contact pests when possible. Spray ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames.

WASPS AND HORNETS - Direct spray at these insects using short bursts. Spray thoroughly into nests, hiding and breeding places when insects have settled at night.

FOR CONTROL OF PESTS ON ORNAMENTAL PLANTS

For control of aphids, two-spotted spider mites and adult white flies on ornamental house and greenhouse plants (African violet, aralia, Christmas cherry, chrysanthemum, cineraria, dieffenbachia, fuchsia, gloxinia, ivy, lantana, Neanthe bella palm, petunia, rose and snap dragon and on outdoor plants, azalea, chrysanthemum, euonymus ivy, mangold, petunia, rose, snap dragon and zinnia). Spray plants with a slow sweeping motion so that mist drifts into plants. Direct spray so that upper and lower leaf surfaces are contacted. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage. Repeat as necessary. When using outdoors spray while air is still. For control of these pests as well as tent caterpillars, canker worms and garden webworm on ornamental crabapple, cherries and plum trees, spray as above. Do not spray bearing fruit trees.

CAUTIONS: Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before re-use. When using the product in these areas apply only when the facility is not in operation. Do not use on or around animals. Cover or remove fish bowls for 1 hour. Avoid breathing of vapor and skin contact. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact, flush with water. Do not smoke while spraying.

WARNING: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Replace no wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose of in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: If inhaled, remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. If in eyes or on skin, flush affected parts with water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is extremely toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, benthos, etc.) and drift from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in adjacent sites.
