

DIRECCIONES DE USO: Sostenga la lata verticalmente con la boca hacia arriba a usted. Empuje la válvula hacia abajo y retire el compo-

PARA EL CONTROL DE INSECTOS CASEROS:

Para controlar moscas, mosquitos pequeños, polillas, avispas, abejas, o avispas, cierre las puertas y ventanas. Remueva los animales caseros, platos y cubra los acuarios de peces antes de rociar. Mantenga el cuarto cerrado por lo menos 10 minutos después de rociar. No se quede en la área tratada y ventile las áreas después de que el tratamiento haya sido completado.

Para matar cucarachas y peces de corral. Rocíe directamente en las grietas y rendijas y otros sitios apartados. Dirija el rociado directamente a los insectos cuando aparecen. Una cocina de tamaño regular requiere que se rocíe a rededor de 1 a 2 pies lineales por segundo. Para matar hormigas. Rocíe los insectos directamente y los senderos y otros lugares donde las hormigas se congregan.

APPROXIMATE INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE
 INDOOR APPLICATION

The use of this product in food processing establish-
 ments should be confined to time periods when the
 plant is not in operation. Food should be removed
 or covered during treatment. All food processing
 surfaces should be covered during treatment or thor-
 oughly cleaned before using.

Vacate treated area and ventilate before reoccupy-
 ing.

For maximum effectiveness, a combination of spot sur-
 face treatment and fogging is recommended.

SURFACE SPRAYING: To control roaches, ants, silver-
fish, spiders, crickets, clover mites, cheese mites,
granary weevils, rice weevils, confused flour beetles,
sawtoothed grain beetles, spider beetles, cigarette
beetles, drugstore beetles, meal worms, grain mites,
and caddis: Use a good sprayer adjusted to deliver
 a coarse wet spray. Direct the spray into hiding
 places, cracks and crevices, under pallets, around
 containers of stored foods, around the base of machi-
 nery, behind shelves and drawers. For silverfish,
 spray bookcases. For ants, spray trails, nests and
 points of entry. If surface application only is to
 be used, spray floors, walls, and other surfaces
 applying at a rate of 1 gallon to 750 square feet of
 surface.

To control carpet beetles: Spray edges of carpeting
 and under carpeting and rugs. Make localized ap-
 plication to floor and baseboards. Spray directly
 into cracks, closets and infested areas of shelving.
 Repeat treatment as needed.

To control bedbugs: Spray mattresses lightly, par-
 ticularly tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray
 in all joints. Repeat treatment as needed.

BEST DOCUMENT AVAILABLE

To control flies and gnats: Thoroughly spray infested areas, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind base rails, partitions, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor covering. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Concurrent treatment of animals with an approved insecticide is recommended. Repeat treatment as needed.

To control clothes moths: Remove any infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus, and other storages, directing spray into cracks, joints, and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated lightly keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining.

SPACE SPRAYING: Close doors and windows and shut off ventilating systems. Apply with a good machine adjusted to deliver a fine mist or fog. For rapid control of flies, fruit flies, gnats, mosquitoes, skipper flies, wasps, hornets, Angoumois grain moths, Mediterranean flour moths, Indian meal moths and tobacco moths: direct spray at an upward angle, distributing it uniformly throughout the entire area at a rate of 3-6 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space.

FOGGING: To fill exposed or accessible stages of the above named crawling insects, use a rate of one gallon to 20,000 to 40,000 cubic feet of space. Contact insects directly whenever possible.

ON ANIMALS: To protect cattle and horses from horn flies, house flies, mosquitoes and gnats, apply a light mist sufficient to wet the surface of the hair. To control stable flies, horse flies, and

flies, apply at a rate of 1 ounce per adult cow or horse sufficient to wet the hair thoroughly. Repeat treatment daily at intervals necessary to give continued protection.

To control blood sucking lice, apply to the infested areas of the animal using a stiff brush to get spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 2 or 3 weeks if required.

OUTDOOR ADULT MOSQUITO CONTROL: Apply as a fine mist to thoroughly treat the entire area. For best results, treat when the wind velocity does not exceed 5 miles per hour. Treat shrubbery or vegetation where mosquitoes may rest, low marshy places, stagnant pools or ponds and shore lines. Apply at a rate of 1½ gallons per acre (4½ ounces per 10000 square feet).

Using truck-mounted conventional misting equipment such as Rotomist models 51G, 51 or 100 MT, traveling at 5 m.p.h. to treat a 300 foot swath, calibrate equipment to deliver 5.5 gallons per minute.

HAZARD TO HUMAN AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.
