The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. The STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT which was added to the product label should appear under the headings PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS and HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.
2. It is understood that the required signal word appearing on the product label for the pesticide cited above is WARNING and not CAUTION.
3. As per the Agency letters dated April 23, 1990 and May 1, 1991, product-specific product chemistry data is required for the pesticide referenced above. Because product chemistry data is product-specific, it is not acceptable to reference chemistry data from a similar product. In addition, the Agency is awaiting the submission by your supplier of the information regarding the perfume, Oil R-14, per the Agency letter dated May 1, 1991.

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**DIRECTIONS FOR USE** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Hold container upright, nozzle away from you. Press valve down and spray as directed. **FOR THE CONTROL OF HOUSEHOLD INSECTS**  
To control fleas, mosquitoes, houseflies, small flying insects, gnats, or wasps: Shut doors and windows and fill the room with mist. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Keep room closed for at least 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the areas after treatment is completed. To kill roaches & silverfish: Spray directly into cracks, crevices and other secluded places. Contact only at insects when they appear. An average size roach requires spraying of 1 to 2 wheel feet per insect. To kill ants: Spray directly on nests and ant trails and other places where ants congregate.

- IF SWALLOWED Call physician or poison control center immediately. Do not induce vomiting unless directed by physician.
  - IF INHALED Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration indicated.
  - IF IN EYES Flush with plenty of water. Contact physician if irritation persists.
  - IF ON SKIN Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas of skin with soap and water. Contact physician if irritation persists.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**  
**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS WARNING**

Harmful if swallowed. Do not spray near or toward an open flame. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Avoid inhalation of spray mist.  
If used in food processing plants or commercial food preparation areas, foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Apply only while facility is not in operation.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**  
This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Apply this product only as specified on the label. Avoid skin contact. Avoid inhalation of mist.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**  
Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.
