**DIRECTIONS FOR USE
 GENERAL CLASSIFICATIONS**

This is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
 Surface Disinfectant has been designed specifically for use in homes, nursing homes, institutions, offices, schools, motels and hotels as a disinfectant, deodorant and air refresher. It is recommended for use on telephones, bed springs, door knobs, linen carts, mappers, wheel chairs, night stands, garbage cans and other hard non-porous surfaces.
SURFACE DISINFECTANT AND DEODORANT: (1) First remove soil deposits from surface to be treated. (2) Hold can six inches from surface and spray until completely wet. Allow the surface to remain wet for 10 minutes.
AIR DEODORIZER AND AIR REFRESHER: Point spray upwards to center of room and spray for three seconds.
MILDEWSTAT: To control mold and mildew on hard non-porous surfaces such as floors, walls, table tops, spray the surfaces to be treated, making sure to wet completely. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.

When used as directed, Surface Disinfectant is formulated to disinfect inanimate hard surfaces (such as walls, desk tops, telephones, door knobs, draper pins, toilet seats, bed pans, and mappers).
 In addition, this Surface Disinfectant disinfects those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling (such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, rest rooms, shower stalls, and other areas which are the source of odors caused by microorganisms).
 When used as directed, Aerosol Disinfectant demonstrates effective action against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella enteritidis* and *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* and *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*.
 The product is fungicidal against *Paraphyton* (Athletes Foot Fungus) when used as directed on hard surfaces found in the bathroom, shower stall and locker room or other clean hard non-porous surfaces commonly contacted by the bare feet.
MOLD AND MILDEWSTAT: This Surface Disinfectant prevents and controls mold and mildew and the odors they cause on hard non-porous inanimate surfaces when used as directed.
