Rite-Off Total Release Fogger (formerly Fog-Off Total
Release Fogger)
EPA Registration Number 9852-61
Your Submission Dated January 14, 1991

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise the section regarding operation of valve so that the directions appear in the correct chronological order as follows:

TO OPERATE VALVE:

Place several layers of newspaper or pad on stand or table in the center of the room. To lock fogger valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down hooking in catch. Then place fogger on the stand or table. Leave building at once...

2. Based on the labeling provided, we assume you have changed the product name from "Fog-Off Total Release Fogger" to "Rite-Off Total Release Fogger." Please confirm.

Please note that you are responsible for notifying this Agency of any name changes or alternate names used for this product.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, serving or storage areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment and thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperature above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: In accordance with Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

This product will kill cockroaches, flies, ticks, pill bugs, crickets, beetles, saw-toothed grain beetles, rice weevils, small house flies, fleas, ticks, pill bugs, crickets. Cover exposed food, dishes, dishes, and other eating equipment. Open all doors and windows to area to be treated. Shut off fans, lights, and other electrical equipment. Put out all flames or pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of treated area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not possible. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before reentry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To prevent automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down hooking up the release valve. Place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open. Cover floor with layers of newspaper or plastic for paper. Leave building at once and keep doors and windows closed for four hours before reentry. Open all doors and windows and allow to ventilate for two weeks or when necessary.

To kill ticks and fleas, wash pet bedding and replace the product as above. Treat dogs and cats with registered flea and tick product prior to reentry.
