DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE CAN BEFORE USING
KEEP CAN SEALED

FOR USE ON CARPETS: Mix dusts of dust and shake powder evenly across the surface. Use a brush and gently sweep over surface to allow the powder to penetrate fibers of the carpet. **WAIT 60 MINUTES.** **AND THEN VACUUM.** For spills and stains, where ticks are known to be hiding, wait 3 hours before vacuuming. If powder adheres to a spot, brush it out and vacuum immediately. Apply to dry surfaces only. Do not allow powder to become wet.

FOR USE ON UPHOLSTERY: Remove loose cushions and sprinkle along all creases, in corners, and along gently. **WAIT 60 MINUTES. THEN VACUUM.** Do not use on exposed floor. May cause staining. Remove bag from vacuum cleaner, wrap securely in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Test hidden surface of carpet or upholstery before treating. If exposure or is affected, do not use.

Clean carpets after using this product.
