TO OPERATE VALVE To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.
CONSIDER EXPOSED FOODS, DISHES AND FOOD-HANDLING EQUIPMENT Open cabinets and drawers in area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

THIS PRODUCT WILL KILL ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, FLEAS, HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, RICE WEEVILS, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS AND TICKS.

TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS: Old bedding should be removed and replaced with fresh, clean bedding after treatment. Pets should be treated with an E.P.A. registered product for fleas and ticks in conjunction with this treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool dry area away from heat and open flame. Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
