 - d. The section entitled "STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT" should be rewritten to state the following treatments:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of

water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat induce vomiting by touching back of throat with chooses If person is unconscious, do

not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

IF INHALED:

Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration,

preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention

IF ON SKIN:

Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES:

Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

e. In the "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS"

The title "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" should be expressed as bold letters.

The precautionary statements must be corrected as follows:

"CAUTION: Harmful if ingested or inhaled. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs."

- f. In the "Environmental Hazards" section remove the statement "Do not apply directly to lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries" since there are no directions for any outdoor uses.
- g. In the section entitled "Physical and Chemical Hazards" Rite-Off, Inc. must insert the statement "Do not apply this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard." because the data matrix does not provide a dielectric breakdown voltage.
- h. In the section labeled "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" "STEP 2: ACTIVATION OF FOGGER" correct the spelling for the word "spraying", which is spelled "straying" in the last sentence.
- i. In the section of the label that states "IMPORTANT! to avoid "FLAMMABILITY HAZARD, use can as follows:
 - Only one can per room.
 - Do not place in cabinet or under counter or table...
 - Shut off electrical equipment.
 - Place can at least 6 feed from pilot lights."

The last 2 statements imply that there is a flammability and/or potential for electrical shock. Data has not been submitted by Rite-Off, Inc. to determine the flashpoint or Dielectric Breakdown Voltage. This section should be moved and positioned directly under the title "DIRECTIONS FOR USE"

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Aiming spray away from face, set fogger on newspaper, leave room and close door. After solivation, leave room or house at once. Keep area closed for 2 hours (30 minutes for flying insects) before airing out. Open all doors and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat straying in two weeks or when necessary.
