## THIRAM 75

Thiram 75 may be used on golf greens, lawns, grass, tennis courts and other fine turf. Will usually prevent and control large brown patch, and dollar spot.

May also be combined with mercurial turf fungicides for broader, more effective disease control and reduction of possible toxic effects on turf caused by mercurial fungicides.

### DIRECTIONS

#### BROWN PATCH, DOLLAR SPOT:

Make regular spray applications at 7 to 10 days beginning before the earliest probable appearance of the disease and continuing throughout the season. During weather particularly conducive to fungus disease it may be necessary to spray every 3 to 5 days.

Treatment	Rate per 1,000 sq. ft.	Rate per 5,000 sq. ft.
Preventive	3 ozs. *	15 ozs.
Curative	6 ozs.	30 ozs.

\* 1 cupful equals 3 ozs.

#### SNOW MOLD:

Use 8 ozs. per 1,000 sq. ft. as late in the Fall as possible, prior to snowfall. Follow with a Spring application of 3 ozs. per 1,000 sq. ft. as soon as the snow melts.

#### WATER:

Apply with enough water (5 to 10 gals. water per 1,000 sq. ft.) to give complete coverage of area to be treated.

Thiram 75 is insoluble in water and will tend to settle out unless constantly agitated.

DO NOT water or mow grass after treatment until the fungicide is thoroughly dry.

For Imperial Gallons use 20% more Thiram 75.

### IMPORTANT

DO NOT permit animals to feed or graze on treated areas. DO NOT use grass clippings from treated areas for food or feed purposes. Thiram is toxic to fish; avoid spray drift to fish pools and ponds.

### CAUTION!

May cause irritation of eyes, nose, throat, and skin. Harmful if inhaled or swallowed.

Avoid breathing dust or spray mist.

Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing.

In case of contact, flush with plenty of water; for eyes, get medical attention.
