## RECOMMENDATIONS AND DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CORN (Field and Sweet): Broadcast Application - Larvae of White-fringed Beetles - Apply 12½ to 20 lb. per acre. Cutworms - Apply 8 to 20 lb. per acre. Apply chlordane after field is plowed. Disk in promptly. Use higher rate on heavier infermation of cutworms.

The use of this product to control white-fringed beetle larvae on corn is restricted to 8 south-eastern states (AL, FL, GA, LA, MS, NC, SC, TN).

The use of this product on corn is continued unti. August 1, 1976 only.
