DIRECTIONS

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is compatible with virtually all corrosion inhibition additives. At use dilution it is non-corrosive to inanimate hard surfaces.

Clean heavily contaminated systems before treatment. If soap or anionic detergent is used, rinse thoroughly before charging with algaecide. Apply this product at a point in the system where uniform mixing will take place. Organic debris should be removed from the system to avoid clogging of screens and pipes.

INITIAL DOSE: 1 to 2 gallons "Aqua-Tech" TSC-901 to each 5,000 gallons of water contained in the system. Repeat until control is evident.

PERIODIC DOSE: 1 to 3 quarts "Aqua-Tech" TSC-901 per 5,000 gallons of water every 7 days or sooner, should visible growth appear.

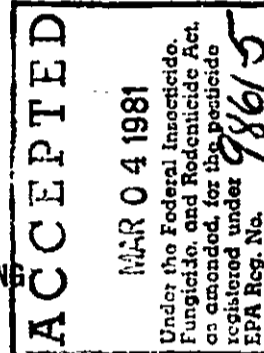

PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before re-use. If swallowed, promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites or gelatin solution. If these are not available, drink large amounts of water. Avoid alcohol.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing manually or mechanically may be needed. If persistent, convulsions may be controlled by the cautious intravenous injection of a short-acting barbiturate drug.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Keep container closed when not in use. When empty, container should be rinsed thoroughly with water and discarded in a safe place away from water supplies. Do not re-use container. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste.
