The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. Delete "GENERAL USE CLASSIFICATION."
- b. Delete "COMPOSITION:" above the ingredient statement.
- c. Add the following statement to the Handling section:

Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.
- d. Include the following statement in the first paragraph under APPLICATION:

Apply this product at a point in the system where uniform mixing will take place.
- e. The statement "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" should appear beneath the heading Precautionary Statements on the right panel. Delete this statement from the center (front) panel.
- f. Relocate the Environmental Hazards up above the storage section. This is considered part of the precautionary statements. Also, change "product" to "pesticide" in the first statement of the Environmental Hazards.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

GENERAL USE CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

APPLICATION

This product is compatible with virtually all corrosion inhibition additives. At use dilution it is non-corrosive to inanimate hard surfaces. Clean heavily contaminated systems before treatment. If soap or anionic detergent is used, rinse thoroughly before charging with algaecide. Organic debris should be removed from the system to avoid clogging of screens and pipes.

INITIAL DOSE: 1 to 2 gallons "Aqua-Tech" TSC-901 to each 5,000 gallons of water contained in the system. Repeat until control is evident.

PERIODIC DOSE: 1 to 3 quarts "Aqua-Tech" TSC-901 per 5,000 gallons of water every 7 days, or sooner should visible growth appear.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, or gelatin solution. If these are not available, drink large amounts of water. Avoid alcohol.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
