Directions for Use

FOR HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS: Dilute 6.4 oz. per gallon with deodorized base oil. Close windows and doors. Spray freely toward ceiling in all directions until room is filled with mist, then leave the room. Keep doors closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

WASPS: Dilute 6.4 oz per gallon with base oil. Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

FOR ROACHES, ANTS, SPIDERS: Dilute 32 oz. per gallon with deodorized base oil. Spray thoroughly into cracks, crevices, and other hiding places. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

When used in restaurants, kitchens and food processing plants, foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation."

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place.
