PROCEDURE

Place the article to be treated in an air-tight area or container, if possible. Sprinkle crystals generously on top or punch holes in this can and place it on top of the materials to be protected. Use one pound per 100 cubic feet of closed space, such as closets, chests and trunks. The space should be kept tightly closed at all times and for at least seven days after the addition of the crystals. Woolens should be thoroughly brushed or cleaned before storing. If closures are opened occasionally, more crystals should be added. If used in a clothes closet or small room, we suggest hanging the can with holes punched in it from the clothes bar or above the articles to be protected as the gas from these crystals is heavier than air and will descend through the materials to be protected.

Paradichlorobenzene Crystals become gas due to chemical reaction when exposed to air. It kills moth larvae that does the actual damage in a period of minutes. It is also effective against moth larvae, house fly and house fly larvae, blue bottle fly and blue bottle fly larvae, carpet beetle and carpet beetle larvae that damage bucktails and similar raw furs. These latter insects destroy the hide rather than the actual hair. It is easy to use and does not have a lasting offensive odor. In the event clothes are treated, air them a short while before wearing to eliminate all odor.
