## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling. Formulators of Germicides must obtain their own registration from the Environmental Protection Agency and develop the data specific for the proposed product.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping prohibited.

**PINE OIL DISPOSAL:** Pine oil that cannot be used should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides from water supplies. Consult Federal, State or Local disposal authorities for approval alternative procedures.

**CONTAINER CLEANING:** Steam Tank Car/Tank Truck and wash with a suitable detergent.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS**  
**DANGER:** Causes eye burns and skin irritation. Do not get in the eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.
