


## FOLLOW DIRECTIONS CAREFULLY FOR HOSPITAL CLEANLINESS: TO BLEACH DISINFECT DEODORIZE SANITIZE

TO BLEACH: WASHER --- Mix 1 cup Bleach to wash solution. AUTOMATIC - Add 1 cup Bleach to water in machine. SOAK OR RINSE - Mix 1 cup Bleach to tub. SICK ROOM --- TOWELS, LINEN, etc. Wash as above. Then soak 5 to 15 minutes in solution of 1 oz. Bleach to gallon of water. Rinse well. BABY'S THINGS ---- Sweet, clean, snowy white. Wash regular Bleach way. DIAPERS ---- Flush in toilet bowl to remove substantial matter. Soak 30 minutes in solution of 1 oz. Bleach to gallon of water, rinse thoroughly. TO REMOVE STAINS like SCORCH, FRUIT, TEA, COFFEE, MILDEW, GRASS, etc. Soak in 1 oz. Bleach to quart of water. Rinse well. From TILE, SINK and DRAINBOARD, ENAMELWARE, etc. Swab Bleach full strength with wet cloth. Rinse well.

DEODORIZE - REFRIGERATOR, STOVE, GARBAGE CAN. Wash. Rinse. Swab with solution 1 oz. Bleach to quart of water. TOILET BOWL, TUB, WASHBOWL. Cleanse and swab with 3 oz. Bleach to quart of water. Leave Bleach in toilet bowl a few hours. ONION, GARLIC, FISH, CABBAGE, MOLD, etc. Wash surface. Soak about 10 minutes in solution 1 oz. Bleach to quart water.

## **KEEP IN A COOL PLACE**

TO DISINFECT GLASSWARE, DISHES, DRAINBOARDS, FLOORS, TILE, PORCE-

LAIN SEATS, LOCKERS, BED PANS. Cleanse — wash — rinse in solution 1

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN RESTAURANTS, TAVERNS, SODA FOUNTAINS, DAIRIES, ETC.: for disinfecting thoroughly cleansed surfaces:

1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.

2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner (a commercial cleaner or detergent can be recommended).

4. Sanitize in a solution of 1 ounce to 2 gallons of water (200 p.p.m.) Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes for contact time specified by

5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.

CAUTION. TO DISINFECT. Cleanse BEFORE use of disinfectant. Bleach must be diluted or it may irritate eyes, skin or lungs. Keep strength of solution 250 P.P.M. available chlorine. 1 oz. Bleach to gallon of water equals 400 P.P.M. DO NOT MIX WITH OTHER HOUSEHOLD CHEMICALS.
