- b. The heightened efficacy claim "Powerful" has been removed from the label.
- c. Based upon data placing it in toxicity category I for primary skin and eye irritation, this product meets the Agency requirements for Child-Resistant Packaging (CRP).
- d. Move the "First Aid" statement to the front of the label.
- e. Under the "Precautionary Statements" section of the product label, remove the word "Caution," in the subheading "Hazard to Human and Domestic Animals Caution."
- f. Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.
- g. Based on the proposed disinfectant claims for the product Disposer Care Garbage Disposer Cleaner & Disinfectant, the Agency is not confident that the Use Dilution Method (UDM) adequately addresses the soil load, use patterns, and surface challenges of a garbage disposer. Disinfectant claims, by their inherent nature, imply a higher level of efficacy, and the UDM does not address the orientation of the disposer, acquired organic load, cleaning steps, etc. The Agency will grant conditional registration of disinfectant claims contingent on development and submission of a protocol to address adequate organic burden, necessary cleaning, use patterns, with label-specified use components of disposer to be disinfected. Submission of the protocol is required within 6 months of the date of this registration notice.


