P B F may be used for disinfection of environmental surfaces likely to be contaminated by athlete's foot fungi, Trichophyton metagrophytes (interdigitale).

CAUTION: Flammable mixture. Do not use near fire or flame.

DIRECTIONS

Shake well before each use. Hold can upright and spray into shoe, until fine mist covers interior surface of shoe. Use daily during treatment and then once a week if shoes are worn every day or once a month, if shoes are worn occasionally. Allow shoes to dry before wearing. (Two to three minutes.)

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store above 120°F. Do not puncture or incinerate. Avoid contact with food and food utensils.

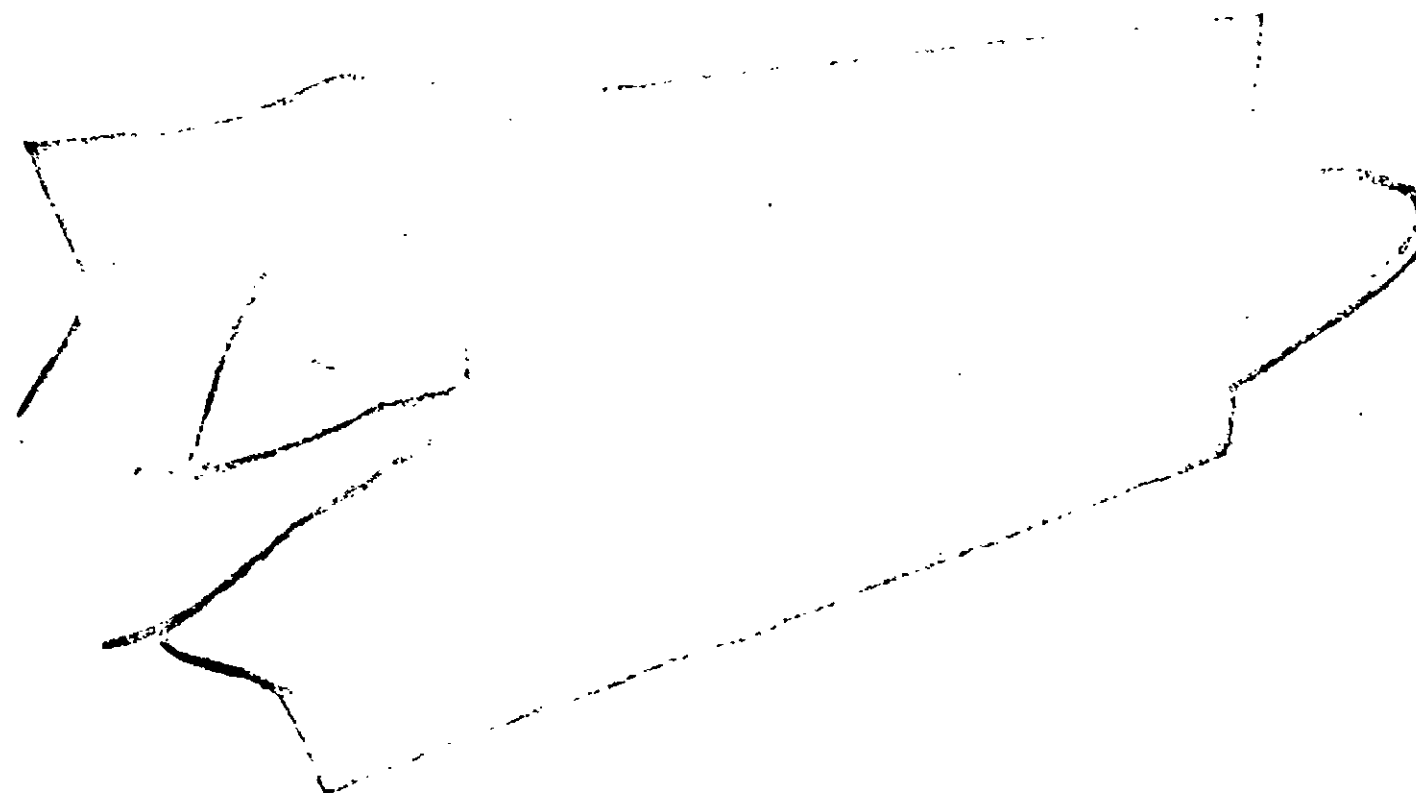
