DIRECTIONS
SHAKE CONTENTS WELL BEFORE USING. ADD ONE PART SANAVENE TO FIVE PARTS WATER TO MAKE SIX GALLONS OF READY TO USE SOLUTION.

TO DISINFECT, DEODORIZE, AND REMOVE STAINS FROM FLOORS, WALLS AND NON-POROUS SURFACES. Clean with prepared disinfecting solution, applying so as to thoroughly wet the surfaces to be treated. Rinse with clear water. SURFACES DIFFICULT TO CLEAN, AND POROUS SURFACES, LAVATORIES, BATHUBS, TILE, FURNITURE, BEDS, TOYS, COMBS, GARBAGE PAILS. Thoroughly wet and clean with solution. Rinse with water.

DISHES, GLASSWARE, SILVERWARE, FOOD UTENSILS. After thorough cleaning, disinfect by immersing in the prepared solution. Let air-dry. Do not use a towel. Rinse with clean water before using.

RUBBER GOODS. Clean thoroughly to remove any adhering matter, soak in disinfecting solution for 10 minutes, and rinse with clean water.

SURGICAL INSTRUMENTS. Clean instruments thoroughly to remove all adhering blood and serous exudates, then immerse in the disinfecting solution for 10 minutes. Sanavene contains a corrosion inhibitor to protect instruments.

MOLD CONTROL OF WALLS AND CEILINGS. Sponge and clean with disinfecting solution. Rinse with clean water.

CLOTHING, BEDDING, DIAPERS. To disinfect and deodorize, soak in solution for 20 minutes, then rinse with clean water.

RUGS, CARPETS. Remove all surface dirt with a vacuum cleaner or a brush. To clean and deodorize, use a soft brush or towel dipped into the solution frequently. Stroke back and forth, up and down, in a one square foot area until color clears. Use squeeze mop for areas up to 3 square feet. Rinse off dissolved dirt with a clean cloth, or a moist mop.

UPHOLSTERY, FABRICS. To clean and deodorize, use a rough towel, sponge, or a soft brush dipped into the solution frequently and stroke back and forth, up and down, in a one square foot area until color clears. Rinse off dissolved dirt with a clean cloth, slightly damp. For deep stains such as coffee, drinks, etc., apply Sanavene concentrate full strength. Let dry, then clean whole piece with diluted solution. Rinse with a damp cloth. To prevent discoloration or shrinking, test the material in an inconspicuous place.

TOILET BOWLS. Flush the toilet to expel the residual water and to wet the surfaces. Dip brush into a stronger solution made of one part Sanavene concentrate and two parts of water. Thoroughly brush toilet, then flush.
