VITA KING FLY CONTROL BLOCK, medicated

Prevents the breeding of horse flies and face flies in the animals on treated cattle; aids in the prevention of stomach worms, hookworms and nodular worms when used as directed; aids in the prevention of foot rot and soft tissue lumpy jaw; nutritional source of iodine.

INGREDIENTS

Coarse meal, hydrolyzed protein, lactose, alfalfa meal, rice
starch, salts, magnesium carbonate, calcium carbonate, grain sorghum
flour, deflourinated phosphate, low flourine rock phosphate, fish meal,
meat and bone scrap, benzoate, rice bran, cane molasses,
Vitamin A supplement, Vitamin E & D₃ supplement, manganese oxide,
zinc oxide, iron oxide, cobalt carbonate, copper oxide, iodine
and artificial flavors added.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Self Feed 3/4 oz. of Vita King Fly Control Block per day per head
100 lbs. of body weight. (Ensure to put out an ample supply of
blocks -- at least one block for every 10 heads). Locate blocks
near the animal's water or ear tag branding area. Keep plenty
of Vita King Fly Control Blocks available. If the supply of
runs out, do not expect a normal control to fully continue.

Do not feed any other salt or mineral. Vita King Fly Control Blocks contain all the additional salt and mineral required by cattle when consumed at the proper rate.

The active ingredients of Vita King Fly Control Blocks have been biologically tested against the horn fly, and guaranteed to effectively prevent the breeding of adult flies. The secret of the horn flies is the nature of treated cattle, as indicated below.

For maximum protection against horn flies, cattle should be sprayed at the start of the fly season, and fed Vita King Fly Control Blocks continuously, beginning several weeks before the fly season and until all adult horn flies have disappeared in the fall. Vita King Fly Control Blocks prevent the breeding of horn flies and face flies in the nature of treated cattle, but does not affect any existing adult flies.

Do not feed to lactating dairy animals.

Occasional sensitivity to phenothiazine has been reported in cattle.
