**MUNICIPAL CONTROL OF HOUSEFLIES AND MOSQUITOES:** Mix 1 gallon with 40 gallons of water to treat 1 acre. Treat breeding areas paying particular attention to garbage heaps, city dumps, sewage disposal areas and livestock pens. Thoroughly wet all the surfaces.

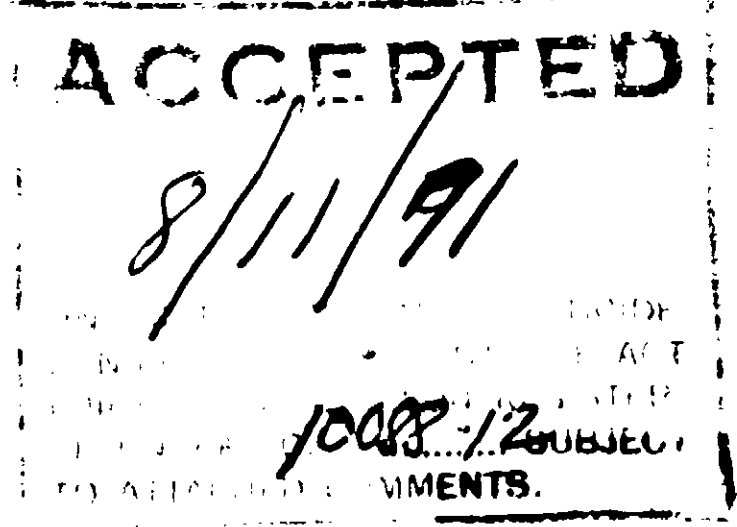
For Mosquito control in parks, industrial areas, suburban residential areas, etc. Dilute 1 gallon to 50 gallons in water, use 30 to 40 gallons per hour as fog or mist to treat one acre.

For Controlling Lawn Insects on Greens, Tees and Fairways; Wash into ground thoroughly and allow to dry before allowing children and pets on lawn.

**FOR COCKROACHES:** Mix 1 gallon to 13 gallons of water, apply as a coarse wet spray around building foundations and pipes, on garbage dumps and around garbage storage racks.

**JAPANESE BEETLE LARVAE:** Mix 2½ gallons with sufficient water to cover one acre. After applying, wash into the soil.

**CHIGGERS AND LAWN MOTHS (SOD WEBWORMS):** Water thoroughly before applying. Apply at the rate of 1 to 2 gallons in sufficient water to cover one acre.
