The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, changing the declaration of Petroleum distillate from active to inert, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Submit the product-specific product chemistry data and data matrix for this product. Include a 1-year storage stability study.
2. Remove the statement "Contains petroleum distillate" from under the PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS heading and add it as a footnote to the INERT INGREDIENTS just below the label ingredient statement.
3. If you do not provide a dielectrical breakdown voltage, you must add the following statement to the PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS heading:

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.
