**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly after using and before eating or smoking. Do not allow children or pets in treated areas until sprays have dried.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or poison control center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Contains petroleum distillate. Aspiration is a potential hazard.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes and under eyelids with water for at least 15 minutes. Obtain medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and launder before re use. Wash skin with soap and water. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is highly toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not store or use near heat or open flame.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

**FOR USE IN NON-FOOD PROCESSING FACILITIES
ALSO HOTELS, MOTELS, INSTITUTIONS**

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a contact product in a manner inconsistent with its use.

SPACE SPRAY TO KILL FLIES: Spray in room or area to be treated. Turn off ventilation system. Seal all openings. Apply this product undiluted through manually operated equipment. Avoid staining by holding the nozzle at a distance from objects. Direct spray mist toward the rate of 5 fluid ounces per 500 sq ft for at least one half hour. Sweep. Ventilate thoroughly before re-occupancy.

CONTACT SPRAY TO CONTROL EARWIGS, GRAIN MITES, SOYBEAN BEETLES: Adjust sprayer to produce a coarse mist in cracks and crevices in floors, walls, cabinets, and similar places where insects hide. Repeat as necessary.

NON FOOD AREAS OF FOOD PROCESSING FACILITIES: Do not use in food areas or restaurants or other areas where food is prepared or processed. Do not use in areas where food is exposed or facility is in operation. If food is served such as dining room, food may be prepared or held on surfaces and utensils should be thoroughly washed before use or removed.

NON-FOOD AREAS: Includes drains (to sewer), entries and machine rooms, boiler rooms, canning or bottling).

NON FOOD AREAS - SPOT TREATMENT: Apply with coarse low pressure spray around walls, pipes, beneath storage areas and similar areas where silverfish hide.

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
