

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

This product is used to control algae and bacteria in recirculating commercial and industrial water cooling towers. Prior to its use, systems must be cleaned to remove algae growth, microbiological slime and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 5.1 to 10.2 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water is recommended.

Subsequent slug additions of 1.7 to 10.2 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleed-off and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump of water cooling towers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a dry place no lower in temperature than 50°F. or higher than 120°F.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
