This is in response to your amendment to reflect product name change from "Swimming Pool Algaecide II" to "Super Shock Algaecide".

The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with Registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable provided you make the following changes.

- 1. Delete the word "Specimen Label" from the proposed label.
- 2. The Companys "Name and Address" must be placed on the label.
- 3. Under the "Direction for Use" delete the heading "General Classification".
- 4 Revise the Environmental Hazards to read as follows:

"This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA".

DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

This algaecide is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whiripools, hot tubs and decorative fountains, For maximum effectiveness, pools, spas, whirlpools and decorative fountains containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using this product.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 75 to 116 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water and remove the settle algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pools, add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 13.6 to 27 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs and decorative (ountains having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 8 to 12 ounces per 1,000 gallons of water, For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirtpool, hot tub or decorative fountain, add initially 4 to 8 ounces per 1,000 gallons of water, Subsequent additions of 1 to 3 fluid ounces should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

This algaecide is compatible with chemicals normally used to treat pools, spas and decorative fountains, and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. It can be used In pools, spas and decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix with concentrated dry of liquid chlorine products, 63091626

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
