The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the **Busan 77 RED** and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.


Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statement of Formulation (CSF) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

For Commercial Use.

This algicide is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs and decorative fountains. For maximum effectiveness, pools, spas, whirlpools and decorative fountains containing heavy growth of algae must be cleaned prior to using this product.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 75 to 116 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water and remove the settle algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pools, add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 13.6 to 27 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water must be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs and decorative fountains having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 8 to 12 ounces per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, hot tub or decorative fountain, add initially 4 to 8 ounces per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 to 3 fluid ounces must be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

This algicide is compatible with chemicals normally used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains, and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. It can be used in pools, spas and decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat procedure two more times.
Container Handling For Greater than 5 gallons
Container Handling: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill container. Offer for recycling, if available. If not, puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. Clean container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinse into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinse for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.
