GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is an effective total kill herbicide for use on non-crop areas for control of many annual and perennial weeds and grasses. The degree of control and duration of effect will vary with the amount of product applied, soil type, rainfall, and other conditions.

Apply this product just before or during the period of active growth of plants to be controlled, and when rainfall can be expected for soil activation. Because it works through the soil, results will be improved by removing dense vegetation growth before treatment. Effects are slow to appear and may not become apparent until the chemical has been carried into the root zone by moisture. Do not apply when the ground is frozen.

WEED CONTROL: To control most weeds for an extended period of time on non-cropland areas such as railroad, highway, and pipeline right-of-ways, petroleum tank farms, lumber yards, storage areas, and industrial sites.

To control annual weeds and grasses such as foxtail, ryegrass, wild oats, crabgrass, cheatgrass, ragweed, lambquarters, purslane, orchardgrass and turkey mullein: Apply 4 1/2 to 8 1/2 gallons per acre diluted with sufficient water to allow for uniform application. For small areas, use 8 1/2 ounces in approximately 4 gallons of water to treat 250 square feet.

To control perennial weeds and grasses such as smooth brome, bahiagrass, bluegrass, purpletop, quackgrass, broomsedge, dog fennel, aster, goldenrod, and plantain: Apply 8 1/2 to 17 1/2 gallons per acre diluted with sufficient water to allow for uniform application.

To control hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses such as johnsongrass, bermudagrass, dallisgrass, nuttall's, saltgrass, bouncingbet, dogbane, and horsetail: Apply 17 1/2 to 35 gallons per acre diluted
