HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION**

Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Wash thoroughly after handling.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine only by injection is an antidote.

**IF ON SKIN:** In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with plenty of soap and water.  
**IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with plenty of water.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on plants. Protective information may be obtained from your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service. This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams, pond, tidal marshes and estuaries. Shrimp and crabs may be killed at application rates recommended on this label. Do not apply where these are important resources. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** This product controls the pests indicated in the areas listed below by application of the product as an undiluted spray (containing 0.5% chlorpyrifos). Repeat treatments as needed.

Do not apply sprays of this product in conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. Do not use in poultry houses or other animal buildings. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs or water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils with soap and water if they become contaminated by application of this product. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Remove pets and cover fish bowls (tanks) before spraying.

**APPLICATION WITHIN RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS:** Including homes, apartment building and nonfood areas of industrial, institutional and commercial buildings (including hospitals, stores, manufacturing plants and warehouses). **FOR SPOT TREATMENT ONLY.**

**TO CONTROL COCKROACHES** (including strains resistant to other insecticides), **ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, FIREBRATS, SILVER FISH AND SPIDERS:** Apply as a coarse spray or with a paint brush to localized areas where these pests are found or normally occur, including dark corners of rooms and closets; crack and crevices in walls; along and behind baseboards; beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; around plumbing and other utility installations. For ants, apply to ant trails, around doors and windows, and wherever these pests may find entrance. **NOTE:** A period of 4 to 7 days is normally required for maximum effect on cockroaches.

**TO CONTROL CARPET BEETLES:** Thoroughly spray for spot treatment along baseboards, closets and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, in closets and on shelving, and wherever else these insects are seen or suspected.

**TO CONTROL FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS:** Thoroughly spray for spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet area. **DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.** To control the source of flea infestation, pets inhabiting the treated premises should be treated with a product registered for application to animals.

**TO CONTROL FLIES AND MOSQUITOES:** aid in reducing annoyance from flies and mosquitoes on screens, doors, window frames and room. Also treat surfaces around and other places where insects are necessary.

**ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS, CRICKETS, FIREBRATS, SILVER FISH AND SPIDERS:** treatment of localized infestations where there are voids or cracks. Apply thoroughly. For ants, wet hills and infestation warrants and as recommended.

**APPLICATION WITHIN FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS:** other than private residences or served) including, but not limited to, bakeries, bottling plants, canneries, meat and poultry processing plants, and around both food and nonfood areas. Do not introduce spray into food or food contact surfaces. Apply as a coarse, low pressure spray to corners of rooms and closets, and behind stoves, refrigerators, and equipment, floor drains; and installations. For ants, apply to ant trails, around doors and windows, and wherever these pests may find entrance. Spot treatment by applying small amount of insecticide to voids and hollow spaces between equipment and floor elements of construction. Use a pin stream of insecticide. Repeat applications every 7 days in establishments or more often in food handling establishments. This product may be applied after emergency use should be required. **APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS IS NOT RECOMMENDED.**

**STORAGE**

Do not contaminate water or food. Keep container closed. If container is damaged or leaking, spilled material with glass or other sharp objects. Do not use for proper disposal. Store at room temperature, then spray. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** For disposal of excess pesticide, contact your local health department or environmental representative at the nearest health department. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** For recycling or reconditioning, contact your local health department, landfill, or incineration, or by burning. If burned, state and local health department should be notified.

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
