**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Do not apply when food processing is underway.

**TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS:** Close room, warehouse or other area to be treated and shut off all ventilating systems. Dispense product as a fine mist using a hand sprayer, mist sprayer or thermal fogger. Use 1/2 to 1 fluid ounce per 1000 cubic feet of room space. Do not remain in treated area. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Ventilate area after treatment is completed. Repeat application as needed for insect control.

**TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS AND CRICKETS:** Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves, refrigerators and wherever pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat door sills, window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Keep container tightly closed when not in use. If container is damaged or leaking, contain spill. Soak up spilled material with sand or other inert absorbent and place in a closed, labeled container for proper disposal. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by State and Local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of the smoke.
