Amended Labeling; Updates for PR Notice 2007-4 CONTACT INSECTICIDE, EPA Reg. No. 10088-96 Your Submission Dated June 30, 2010

Dear Mr. Swader:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following label revision provision(s):

## **General Statement:**

- Throughout the subject label, replace all instances of the word "control" or "controls" with the word "kill" or "kills."
- 2. Throughout the subject label, delete all instances of the word "repel" or "repels," since pyrethrins is not a repellent.

## Storage and Disposal Statement section comment(s):

- 3. Revise the existing "Pesticide Storage:" subsection to read "Pesticide Storage: Keep this product in its tightly closed original container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area no lower than 50° F or higher than 120° F that is inaccessible to children and animals."
- 4. In order to facilitate inclusion of language from PR Notice 2007-4, revise the existing "Container Disposal:" subsections to read as follows:

"Container Disposal: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat procedure two more times. Offer for recycling if available for reconditioning if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

**Container Disposal:** Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Offer for recycling if available for reconditioning if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities."

- 8. Revise the 6<sup>th</sup> marketing statement to read "KILLS LISTED CRAWLING AND FLYING INSECTS"
- 9. Revise the 7<sup>th</sup> marketing statement to read "CONTAINS PYRETHRINS, A BOTANICAL INSECTICIDE DERIVED FROM CHRYSANTHEMUMS"

#### GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS

INDOOR APPLICATION: The use of this product in food processing establishments should be confined to time periods when the plant is not in operation. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse before using.

Vacate treated areas and ventilate before reoccupying.

SURFACE SPRAYING: To control Cockroaches, Palmetto Bugs, Ants, Silverfish, Spiders, Crickets, Clovermites, Cheese Miles, Earwigs, Sowbugs, Boxelder Bugs, Centipedes, Granary Weevils, Rice Weevils. Confused Flour Bestles, Rust Red Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Spider Beetles, Cigarette Beetles, Drugstore Beetles, Meal Worms, Grain Mites and Cadalles: Use a good sprayer adjusted to a coarse wet spray. Direct the spray into hiding places, cracks and crevices, under pallets, around containers of stored foods, around the base of machinery behind shelves and drawers, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets, along baseboards, around door and window frames, into dark corners and in and around garbage compactors, garbage chutes and cans. For Silverfish, spray bookcases. For Ants, spray trails, nests and points of entry. If surface application only is to be used, spray floors and other surfaces applying at a rate of 1 gallon to 750 square feet of surface,

In case of infested foods in cabinets, dispose of the infested material, Remove all contents and clean thoroughly. Spray interior surfaces of empty cabinets thoroughly. After spray has dried, cover shelves with paper or otherwise protect foods from direct contact with sorayed surfaces.

TO CONTROL CARPET BEETLES: Spray edges of carpeting and under carpeting and rugs. Make localized application to floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, crevices and infested areas of shelving. Repeal treatment

TO CONTROL BEDBUGS: Spray mattresses lightly, particularly around fufts and sooms. Take hade good and soray in all joints. Treat basehoards moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as needed

TO CONTROL CLOTHES MOTHS: Remove any infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible, Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks, joints and cravices. After airing, infested articles may be treated lightly keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to

SPACE SPRAYING: Close doors, windows and transoms and shut off ventilating systems. Apply with a good machine adjusted to deliver a fine mist or fog. For rapid control of House Flies, Fruit Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Skipper Files, Wasps, Hornets, Angournois Grain Moths, Mediterranea Flour Moths, Indianneal Moths and Tobacco Moths, direct spray at an upward angle distribution it uniformly throughout the entire area at a rate of 3-6 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space. Do not remain in treated areas, if insects have not dropped to floor in 3 minutes, repeat spraying as quantity sprayed was insufficient, Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. To aid in the prevention of breeding, spray on standing water and in garbage

FOGGING: To kill exposed or accessible stages of the above named crewling insects, use a rate of 1 gallon to 20,000 to 40,000 cubic feet of space. Contact insects directly whenever possible.

ON LIVESTOCK: To protect callle horses and hops from Horn Files, House Files, Mosquitous and Gnats apply a light mist sufficient to wet the surface of

TO CONTROL STABLE FLIES, HORSE FLIES AND DEER FLIES, apply at a rate of 2 ounces per adult animal sufficient to wet the hair thoroughly. Repeat treatment daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection

TO CONTROL BLOOD-SUCKING LICE, apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 2 to 3 weeks if required.

TO CONTROL POULTRY LICE, spray roost, walls and nests or cages thoroughly. This should be followed by spraying over the birds with a fine mist. FOR CONTROL OF BEDBUGS AND MITES in poultry houses, spray crevices of roost poles, cracks in walls, and cracks in nests where bedbugs and miles

ADULT MOSQUITO CONTROL: Apply as a fine mist to thoroughly treat the entire area. For best results, treat when the wind velocity does not exceed 5 miles per hour. Treat similarly or vegetation where Mesquitoes may rest (low, marshy places, stagnant poots or ponds and shore lines). Apply at a ... of 2.5 pints per acre (0.1 ounce per 100 square feet). Using truck-mr conventional misting equipment such as Rotomist® models 51C, 91 or traveling at 5 m.p.h. to treat a 300 foot swath calibrate equipment to de-

OUTDOORS: (Camping, fishing, hunting) - Spray outer clothing and surroundings. Repels Billing Flies, Mosquitoes, Midges and Grats. If sprayed every hour or so, will aid in keeping surroundings free from Mosquitoes. If in rare cases skin irritation results, avoid continued contact, Do not your or squirt - use a good sprayer which will throw a heavy fine mist.

GARDEN INSECTS ON HOUSE PLANTS AND ORNAMENTAL PLANTS OUTDOORS: Direct spray so that upper and lower leaf surfaces are contacted. To control Aphids, Bagworms, Thrips, Flea Beatles, Japanese Beetles, Lace Bugs, Leaf Hoppers, Leaftlers, Mimosa Webworm Larvae, Plant Burs and Whiteflies use a fine mist spray about 18 to 24 inches from infested plants. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage, Repeat treatment as necessary. Avoid spraying plants when temperature exceeds 85°F. Spray when air is still. Avoid heavy welting.

FLEAS AND TICKS ON DOGS AND CATS: Start spraying at the arimal's head, avoiding the eyes, nose and mouth as you spray. Make sure the animal's entire body is covered including the logs, under-body and tail. While spraying, fluff the hair so that the apray will penetrate the skin, Make sure spray wets thoroughly. Avoid contact with genitalia. Repeat as necessary.

PET AREAS: To control Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks on premises: Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames, and entire areas of floor and floor covering. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal guarters following treatment. Concurrent treatment of animals is recommended. Repeat treatment as needed
