Read all directions before using this product.

Tear open envelope, remove towel; open, and wipe or rub liberally on all exposed skin areas avoiding eyes and mouth. Repeat when insects become annoving. For ticks and chiggers, also apply liberally to shoe tops, socks and around openings of clothing. Repeat using a fresh towel when necessary.

Avoid contact with plastics, such as eyeglass frames, and such fabrics as acetate rayon.
