Overall Lawn Application

Diazinon Granules control the following lawn insects on both grass and dienechra lawns: Chinch Bugs - Earwigs - Ants - Lawn Moths (Sod Webworm) - Bermuda Mites - Crickets - Armyworms - Brown Dog Ticks - Chiggers - Clover Mites - Cutworms - Fleas - Leafhoppers - Sowbugs - Millipede - Springtails - Collembola

Apply Diazinon Granules to your lawn at the rate of 5 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. (an area 10' X 10') or 8 oz. per 100 sq. ft. (an area 10' X 10'). For heavy lawns such as St. Augustine lawns, application should be increased to 7.5 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. or 12 oz. per 100 sq. ft. Application should be made when grass is dry (after lawn has dried) after application. Repeat as necessary.

Flies and White Grubs of Japanese Beetle, European Chafin, Southern Chafin: Apply 5 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. of lawn. Water grass thoroughly after application. For grub control, repeat application any time between late July and early October. For millipede control, apply when activity is high. If activity is low or brown grass indicates damage from millipede, repeat as necessary.

Red and White Weevil (New York only): Apply 5 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. of lawn. Water grass thoroughly after application. Repeat application in mid-April and again in mid-May.

Apply a five-foot band of Diazinon Granules over and around the perimeter of the house.

For control of ants, apply a five-foot band of Diazinon Granules around each ant hole and ground nest opening. Make the nest or hole inactive if the ants are not active.
