The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with comments.

# **Proposed Label Amendment**

Label revisions per PR Notice 2001-1

# **Label Comments**

1. For label clarity and consistency revise the First Aid Statement to read:

FIRST AID						
IF SWALLOWED	<ul> <li>Call a Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.</li> <li>Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.</li> <li>Do not induce vomiting unless told by a Poison Control Center or doctor.</li> <li>Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person</li> </ul>					
IF IN EYES	- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.					
IF INHALED	- Move person to fresh air.  - If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to- mouth if possible.  - Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.					

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# IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING

- Take off contaminated clothing.
- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice

# HOT LINE NUMBER

In case of an emergency call toll free (registrants fill in the number). Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment."

### NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

"Product contains petroleum distillates. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia." Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

The following statements are suggested types of information that may be included, if applicable:

- technical information on symptomatology;
- use of supportive treatments to maintain life functions;
- medicine that will counteract the specific physiological effects of the pesticide;
- company telephone number to specific medical personnel who can provide specialized medical advice.
- 2. Add the sentence directly below the Storage and Disposal heading to read as follows:

# Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal

Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for detailed information.
