# Precautionary Statement Hazard to Humans and Domestic Aicals "WARNING"

- IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of soap and water for 15-20 min. See doctor if irritation develops.
