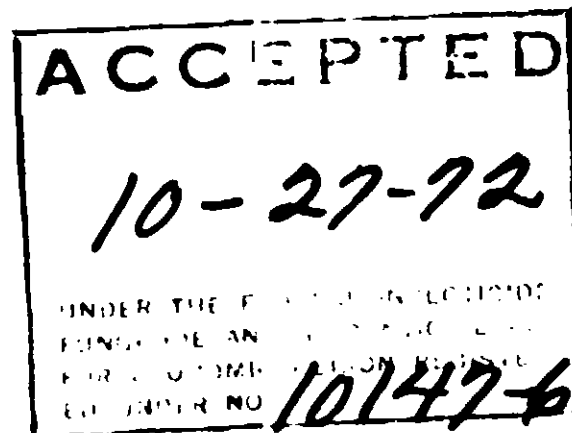

HOW TO USE HI-CHLOR 3600L

AS A LAUNDRY BLEACH:

To whiten fabrics – To rejuvenate suds.

To remove heavy grease stains.

To SANITIZE and REFRESHEN laundry - USE 1/3 pound HI-CHLOR 3600L per 60 gallons of water and 100 pounds of clothes or shrouds.

To DISINFECT double the concentration to SANITIZE.

Do NOT use in colored laundry.

AS A HEAVY DUTY BACTERICIDE

To reduce numbers of bacteria, to kill molds (non-residual), and their slimes in COOLERS, BOXCARS, TRUCKS, WAREHOUSES and PRODUCTION AREAS – Use 1 1/4 ounces of HI-CHLOR 3600L per 5 gallons of water. (625 ppm available chlorine). Apply by mop, dip or spray. Rinse after 10 minutes with potable water.

AS A GENERAL CLEANSER

Add 8-12 ounces HI-CHLOR 3600L per 50 gallons of regular detergent solution used for cleaning tables, benches, rooms, utensils and processing equipment anywhere in the plant where grease and protein are problems. (400 - 600 ppm available chlorine) Rinse well with potable water.

AS A POST RINSE SANITIZER

Dissolve 2 ounces of HI-CHLOR 3600L in 50 gallons of potable water. Mist onto previously cleaned equipment. (100 ppm available chlorine)

AS A POST RINSE SANITIZER

Dissolve 2 ounces of HI-CHLOR 3600L in 50 gallons of potable water. Mist onto previously cleaned equipment. 100 ppm available chlorine.
