DANGER—CORROSIVE

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Before using this product, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected.

FOR CLEANING SMOKEHOUSES WITH FOAM use 4 to 6 quarts per 50 gallons of water, add 1 to 2 quarts of LIQUIK 2 NUBLU per 50 gallons. Fill drum $\frac{1}{2}$ full of cold water before adding the CIRTEC SP. Dissolve. Then fill drum with hot water and when nearly full add the LIQUIK 2 NUBLU. Apply after roughing down and allow to work 1 minute. After cleaning, rinse with potable water.

FOR CLEANING MOLDS AND PANS BY CIRCULATION use 4 to 6 ounces per gallon (12 to 18 pounds per 50 gallons) of water. Fill tank $\frac{1}{2}$ full of cold water before adding CIRTEC SP. Dissolve the CIRTEC tank with hot water and apply steam to bring temperature to 160° F. Immerse molds and pans until clean. Rinse with potable water.

If more soap or suds are desired with improved instability add 1 to 2 cups of LIQUIK 2 NUBLU per 50 gallons.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container. Pest Control Disposal—Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically repurposed must be disposed of according to approved Federal, state or local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act. Container Disposal—Completely empty tank by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of them in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. If drum cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner. Keep dry. Keep container closed when not in use.


