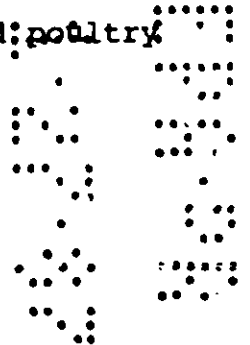

DANGER -- CORROSIVE

AFTER THOROUGH CLEANING AND WASHING

TO SANITIZE POROUS and SEMI-POROUS SURFACES, use 5 oz. BI QUAT in 4 gallons water (1000 ppm quaternaries). Apply by mop, spray, or dip. Rinse after 10 minutes with potable water.

TO SANITIZE FOOD CONTACT SURFACES, use 1 oz. BI QUAT in 4 gallons water (200 ppm quaternaries). Apply by spraying or flooding. Allow surface to remain in contact with solution for 10 minutes. Drain well and air dry. Sanitizer must be prepared fresh daily and more often if solutions becomes diluted or soiled.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container. Pesticide Disposal -- Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate that cannot be used, or chemically reprocessed must be disposed of according to approved Federal, state, or local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act. Container Disposal -- Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. Keep dry. Keep container closed when not in use.
